

Hunt for the Cross Covid-19 Safety Plan

Description:

The "Hunt for the Cross" is a series of outdoor gatherings of no more than 8 guests and 2 hosts at a time held at Westside Family Fellowship, 3791 Hwy 16 West on April 3, 2021.

Preamble:

In order to meet the Covid-19 guidelines for outdoor gatherings the following plan will be in effect for the duration of the gatherings.

Risk Assessment:

Covid-19 is highly contagious by air-borne droplets and there is some evidence of transmission from infected surfaces when a person touches their hands to their face. The first line of defence is to maintain physical distancing between the guests and the hosts, good hand hygiene, and the use of masks.


Individuals that are experiencing the following will not be permitted to participate in the event:

- Anyone who has had symptoms of Covid-19 (or if a member of their household has) in the previous 10 days such as fever, chills, new or worsening cough, shortness of breath, sore throat, new muscle aches, or headache
- Anyone directed by Public Health to self-isolate
- Anyone who has arrived from outside Canada in the last 14 days
- Anyone who has had contact with another who has returned from outside of Canada in the last 14 days
- Anyone who has had contact with a confirmed Covid-19 case in the previous 14 days is required by BC Health Authorities to self-isolate and monitor for symptoms

Please self assess before arriving at the gathering.

Procedures:

1. The gatherings will be outdoors. Limited washroom facilities will be made available if required.
2. Guests are to pre-register for the gathering within their "Trusted Ten".
3. Guests are to self assess before they come to the gathering.
4. Physical distancing will be maintained between the guests and the hosts.
5. Host will wear masks when required.
6. Hand sanitizer will be provided at key locations.
7. All surfaces will be sanitized by the hosts before and after use.
8. All consumable will be single use.
